KOSHER CERTIFICATION

All food prepared and served in the Hebrew Home & Hospital is Kosher
Under my responsibility and supervision according to Orthodox standards

- All food served in the First Floor Coffee Shop is Kosher and Dairy but not *chalav yisroel*.
- All baked goods are *pat yisroel*.
- No one is permitted to bring their food from the outside into the Coffee shop.
- The café is closed on all *Shabbatot* and *Chagim*
- The food is not exclusively *bishul yisroel*
- There is a part-time *mashgiach* on staff in addition to the Rav Hamachshir, Rabbi Daniel Braune-Friedman
- Staff are permitted to bring-in, store, and eat food of their own choosing only in the Basement cafeteria. This unsupervised food may be stored, heated and eaten only in the eating area of the Basement Cafeteria, but does not come in contact with the Hebrew Home serving line or utensils
